Telehealth Consent Form

I am choosing to facilitate in counselling sessions through Stoney Creek Counselling via the internet and Doxy or via telephone. I understand that:

- I must be at least 18 years old to consent to online or telephone counselling
- Internet programs are not 100% guaranteed to be secure and confidential
- All sessions should be treated like an in-office session. No outside distractions: turn off cell phones and close other computer programs. NO third parties will be in or near the session at any time without the counsellor's knowledge
- Technical problems may occur. If the call is disrupted, the counsellor will call you back shortly. If reconnection cannot reoccur, the session will be rescheduled at no additional fee
- If I am in crisis or an emergency situation that needs immediate attention, where I may be considering harming myself or someone else, I will call 911 or immediately go to the nearest hospital emergency room or contact the services below
